NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Special Regulations of Sailing Australia, the ISA Introductory Rules of Sailing (Green Fleet), the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Coaching will be allowed by a Sailing Australia qualified coach with insurance.
- 1.3. Other "On Water" assistants may be directed by designated qualified coaches to assist with "On Water" mentoring of the fleet.
- 1.4. All coaches are directed to not instruct any sailor in the top half of each division in each race, unless there is deemed a risk to safety.
- 1.5. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty including one tack and one gybe.

2. DIVISIONS

- 2.1. Entries are invited from classes of boats including Sabots, Minnows, Vagabonds, O'pen Bics, Training Rig Laser Bugs and including any other bona fide guests who have spoken to the Club Coach regarding the boat they wish to sail.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions:
 - Division 1 Sabots
 - Division 2 Laser Bugs, Minnows, O'pen Bics and other classes less than 2.8m
 - Division 3 All other boats sailed by Juniors
 - Division 4 Learner sailors over 18 years.

The Race Committee reserves the right to change the divisions.

3. ENTRY AND FEES

3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and lodging it before 11:00 on Saturday 4th May 2018 together with the required fee.

3.2. LCSC members \$20 per boat Non-members \$30 per boat LCSC Family: \$30. Non-members family \$40

Competitors in LCSC boats \$30 per boat

3.3. The regatta is open to junior competitors under 18 years, including junior skipper and crew sailing a senior boat and learners of any age who have been approved by the Club Coach to sail in the regatta.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available when registering.

5. COURSES

Triangle courses, windward-leeward, trapezoidal and marathon courses may be used.

6. SCORING

- 6.1. The low point system will be used. Handicaps and yardsticks may be applied.
- 6.2. All races will count. There are no drops.
- 6.3. Should boats be tied at the completion of the series overall, ties will be broken by who finishes in front of the other boat in the final race of the series

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Overall positions in each division.
- 7.2. A "Good Sportsmanship" award may be presented to one person only, chosen from any junior fleet.
- 7.3. Other prizes may be awarded.
- 7.4. Certificates will be given.

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third party insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million.
