

# Vice Commodore's Report

It's been a busy and successful year for the club on land as well as on the water.

The role of Vice Commodore is centred on managing the land based facilities of the Club, particularly the bar.

Trading at the bar has been "brisk" this year with almost identical overall sales figures being recorded to those of the previous year. Gross takings for 2017/18 were approximately \$31,000.

In April 2015, the decision was taken to trial opening the bar on Friday evenings in addition to the customary Sunday sessions after club racing and during regattas. This proved to be a popular decision and, since that time, the bar has been open every Friday all year round from 5pm. Friday night at the "Black Flag Bar" became, and still is, a popular event on the Boreen Point social calendar. During the last year, bar sales on Fridays accounted for approximately 50% of the total takings!
