

Commodore's Report

General Meeting Sunday 16/09/2018

- Following a request from Junior Sailing division the club has purchased a RIB from the Gold Coast Sailing Club. This has been a welcome addition to our Fleet and even has a sun lid on it. Members may view this new acquisition in the boat store under the club.
- The club was successful with its application in Round 96 of the Gambling Community Benefit Fund with a grant of \$15,300 to renew the outboards on Kabi and Brownie. This means that all our outboards will now be less than 4 years old and this hopefully improves the rescue boats reliability and performance.
- Our season opening regatta "The Allboats" attracted 78 senior boats and 38 junior boats with good racing on Saturday and interesting weather on Sunday. This is a great start to the season with 4 of the 6 races scheduled being completed with most of the competitors enjoying the sailing. With the large attendance to this event the club made a good profit for the weekend and I would like to thank all the helpers without whom we could not run these events.
- Club racing has now started with up to 27 senior boats on the water and a heap of juniors as well.
- Sue Germain our hard working Rear Commodore has resigned for health reasons and I would like to thank Sue on behalf of all the Club members for all the work she has put in over the last few seasons and wish her well in the future.
