NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The term "boat" in the following rules and notices also includes windsurfing boards.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Special Regulations of Australian Sailing, the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.3. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. Only for windsurfing boards: RRS rules B3 Touching a mark, B4 42 Propulsion, 43 Drinking Container and 44.2 360°-Turn Penalty apply. No other RRS Appendix B rules apply.

2. DIVISIONS

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of monohull trailer sailors, off the beach monohulls, sailboards and Weta 4.4 Trimarans.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions using the most current Yachting Victoria Yardsticks.

Division 1 - All boats with YS greater than 125

Division 2 - Sailboards and boats with YS up to 125

Division 3 - Impulses

Division 4 - Wetas

The Race Committee reserves the right to change the divisions.

3. ENTRY and FEES

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and lodging it before 1100 hours on 1st December, 2018.
- 3.2. Senior entry fee is \$60, LSCS members \$50. Junior entry fee is \$30 (under 18 yrs), LCSC members \$25 (under 18 yrs).
- 3.3. Competitors taking part in the **Impulse State Titles** must be current financial members of the AIA Inc., a financial member of a Sailing or Yacht club affiliated with a State Yachting Authority and an active Australian Sailing member.
- 3.4. Competitors taking part in the **Weta Queensland State Titles** must be financial members of the Australian Weta Class Association Inc. Arrangements for membership can be made at the event or by visiting https://revolutionise.com.au/awca/

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6. COURSES

Windward leeward & triangle courses will be used. The course will consist of an inner and outer triangle with the outer triangle being for the Wetas.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. The most current Yachting Victoria Yardsticks (YS) for off the beach boats and Class Based Handicaps (CBH) for trailer sailors will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap.
- 7.2. One race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.3. a) When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores.
 - b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

8. PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded based on yardstick positions:

- 8.1. Places in each division.
- 8.2. 1st place in class fleets with 5 or more entries.
- 8.3. Other prizes may be awarded, including specific prizes by participating Class Associations.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million. Proof of insurance may be requested.

12. FOOD

Take-away food will be available from the Coffee Tribe next to the clubhouse. Orders may be placed in advance. A buffet dinner will be available on Saturday from 6.00 pm in the clubhouse for \$18 main plus \$4 for dessert. Catering by Black Ant Gourmet.
