

# Vice Commodore's Report

It's been another busy and successful year for the club on land as well as on the water.

The role of Vice Commodore is centred on managing the land based facilities of the Club, particularly the bar.

Trading at the bar has been up this year, with an increase in overall sales figures of almost 30% being recorded over those for the previous couple of years. Gross takings for 2018/19 were \$40,297.

As has been the case for the last four years, bar sales on Friday nights again accounted for a large proportion of the takings. During the last year, bar trade on Fridays equated to over 50% of the total takings, and is on the increase with the forging of a closer relations between LCSC and the Apollonian Social Club.

Many thanks to the members of the team that have made the bar the success that it's been – Ted Emery, Noel Rickards and chief sausage sizzle coordinators, Paul and Rhonda Herrick and helpers... and of course, the ever thirsty and happy patrons!
