### Rear Commodore Report

**1. Allboats:**

**3. Foiling:**

Follow up item from previous season's GM. Foiling at LCSC was assessed by the Sailing Committee. Low risk was identified for club racing. Potential risk for regattas will be assessed when foiling boats participate next and can be observed.

**5. Boat duty:**
