Please use pencil and eraser to make it look neat and legible.
- Record boats in the table for laps in the order as they go around in the first lap. Make a tick for each lap they did sail and a horizontal line for the laps they did not sail.
- Record boats in the table for finishing time in the order as they cross the line **OR as soon as you become aware that they are OCS or RET.**
- **Ensure that the number of boats in both tables is the same.**
- Tack the timer print out onto the results sheet and leave it in the folder in the bag.
- Anything needing attention re. boats and equipment? Please record under notes.
