

Club sailboats / sailboards policy

This procedure is to ensure the orderly authorisation of the use of the Club sailboats and sailboards.

Club sailboats/sailboards are for the use of LCSC members. They may be used by non-members during the "Come and Try Sailing" or other introduction to the club activities.

The boats can be used for learn to sail programs, during a tutoring session session or club racing. Lending at other times may also be permitted by the responsible officer.

Authorising Officers:

1. Charlie, Minyon, Petra or Tony may authorise use of all learn to sail boats, including Vagabonds, Pacers, Lasers, Minnows and Bic Open.
2. Bernard, Tony or Charlie may authorise use of beginner sailboards and sails up to five square meter sail area. Tony may authorise the use of raceboards and larger sails.

Our sailboats and sailboards are an important asset of the club and it is important that we ensure the responsible use and maintenance of them. Any damage is to be reported to the person authorising use and to be rectified as soon as possible.
