NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the <u>Racing Rules of Sailing</u> (RRS), the special regulations of <u>Yachting Australia</u>, the class rules of the competing boats and by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of off the beach multihulls.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions using Australian Sailing Yardsticks (YS):

Division 1 - YS less than 69,

Division 2 - YS 69 to 74.5,

Division 3 - YS 74.6 to 88,

Division 4 - YS greater than 88.

The Race Committee may change the divisions.

2.3. Eligible boats may enter by using the <u>online registration</u> or lodging an entry form during registration at the club on Saturday 2019-11-02. Payment must be received before 11:00 on 2. November 2019.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Competitor 18 years of age and older: \$60 (LCSC members: \$50).
- 3.2. Competitor under the age of 18 years: \$30 (LCSC members: \$25).

4. SCHEDULE

A maximum of 6 races will be run.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sunday, 2019-11-03

The sailing instructions will be available when registering.

6. COURSES

Windward/leeward courses will be used.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Australian Sailing yardsticks will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap.
- 7.2. 6 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.3. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 7.4. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 8.2. Best sailor under the age of 18 in each division.
- 8.3. Classes of 5 or more boats may be awarded prizes.
- 8.4. Other prizes may be awarded.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third party insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event.
