## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS), the [special regulations of Sailing Australia](#), the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

### 2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of off the beach multihulls, off the beach monohulls, sailboards and trailer sailers.

Hobie State Titles and Javelin Championships scheduled at the lake at the same time have their own NOR and entry forms (see [Hobie - Javelin](#)).

- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions using [Australian Sailing Yardsticks](#) (YS):
  - Division 1 - multihulls YS below 79,
  - Division 2 - multihulls YS 79 and above,
  - Division 3 - monohulls YS below 112,
  - Division 4 - Trailer sailers and monohulls YS 112 and above.

The Race Committee may change the divisions.

- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by using the [online registration](#) or lodging an entry form during registration at the club on Saturday 2020-04-10. Payment must be received before 11:00 on 10 April 2020.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1. Competitor 18 years of age and older: \$75 (LCSC members: \$55).
- 3.2. Competitor under the age of 18 years: \$40 (LCSC members: \$30).

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available when registering.

## 6. COURSES

Triangular and windward/leeward courses may be used.

## 7. SCORING

- 7.1. Australian Sailing yardsticks will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap.
- 7.2. 7 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.3. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 7.4. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score (1 drop).

## 8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 8.2. Best sailor under the age of 18 in each division.
- 8.3. Classes of 5 or more boats may be awarded prizes.
- 8.4. Other prizes may be awarded.

## 9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 10. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

## 11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third party insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event.
