A COVID-19 ATTENDANCE REGISTER IS REQUIRED FOR THE EVENT.

ALL Volunteers & Participants must register including visitors, family and friends attending the event. This information will be collected from skippers when registering online where all members of each grouping need to be recorded.

The clubhouse will be closed until racing finishes each day. The canteen will open 7.30am to 1.30pm Sat & Sun. Lower level toilets will be available by key access only. The bar will open from 5pm on Fri and 4pm Sat & Sun. All patrons must remain seated at tables unless purchasing drinks. A take-away wood-fired pizza will be available from 5pm to 8pm Saturday night from in front of the clubhouse. The clubhouse is limited to a max. number of 50 people at any one time, and the numbers will be monitored. Social distancing must be observed at all times both in and outdoors.

A further attendance register will need to be filled in when entering or leaving any clubhouse facilities including toilets.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the special regulations of Yachting Australia and the Sailing Instructions for the event.
- 1.2. The rules of the competing classes apply. Boats failing to comply with their class rules will have their yardstick adjusted by the race committee.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of trailable boats, off the beach monohulls and multihulls and from sailboards.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into four divisions using Australian Sailing Yardsticks:
Division 1 - Monohulls, Trailer Sailors and Sailboards <150
Division 2 - Multihulls less than 80,
Division 3 - Multihulls 80 and greater,
Division 4 - Dinghies >150
The Race Committee reserves the right to change the divisions.

- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing [online registration](#), prior to 5.00pm on 28/8/2020. **All registrations must be done online.**
Late entries must be lodged online before 10:30 on Saturday 29th August 2020 together with the required fee and a late entry fee of \$20. For any assistance ring Rhonda at canteen on 0439798445.



3. FEES

3.1. Entry fee for the regatta is \$70.00 (LCSC members: \$60).

3.2. For competitors under the age of 18 at the date of the regatta the entry fee is \$30 (LCSC members: \$20). Genuinely skippered by person under 18.
Additional late entry fee \$20.

4. SCHEDULE

Saturday 29th Printed Sailing Instructions available at Canteen from 8am.

Briefing 10:30. There will **not** be a briefing assembly. Notices will be displayed on Canteen window. Sailing instructions will be issued online.

Race 2 back to back with race 1

Sunday 30th

Race 3 10:00*

Race 4 13:00* Race 5 back to back with race 4

Presentation As soon as practical after the last race finishes, there will be no assembly.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be issued electronically to entrants. Changes will be posted on Canteen window.

6. COURSES

Windward leeward & triangle courses will be used.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8. SCORING

8.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute the regatta.

8.2. a) When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores.

b) When 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

9. PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded based on yardstick positions:

Overall positions in each division.

Ancient mariner aged over 70 years.

Seasoned sailor aged between 60 and 70 years.

Master aged over 40 years and apprentice less than 18 years of age sailing together.

Other prizes may be awarded.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event or the equivalent.
