Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing](#) (RRS), the [special regulations of Sailing Australia](#), the class rules of the competing boats and by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of off the beach monohulls, sailboards and trailer sailor boats.
3. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions using [Australian Sailing Yardsticks](#) (YS): (TS will be handicapped using the current CBH, adjusted by the conversion formula to YS. It is imperative that full boat details should be entered in order to enable correct and equitable handicapping.)

Division 1 - Monohulls YS greater than 127.5.

Division 2 - Monohulls YS 109 to 127.5,

Division 3 - Monohulls YS below 109,

Division 4 - Weta 1-up and 2-up

The Race Committee may change the divisions.

- 3.1. Eligible boats may enter On-Line by using <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/lcsc/events/79765/> which will be found on the LCSC Website. No cash/paper payment will be accepted. Registration and payment must be completed by 1100hrs, Saturday 5th December 2020.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Competitor 18 years of age and older: \$70 (LCSC members: \$60).
- 4.2. Junior skipper under the age of 18 years: \$40 (LCSC members: \$40).
- 4.3. Registration is **only** available online at <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/lcsc/events/79765/> and all payment must be made online.

5. SCHEDULE

Saturday 05.12.2020	Registration - Ends at 11:00 On-line only, cashless payments. Briefing will not be held due to Covid19 restrictions. Race 1 1230* Race 2 back to back with race 1
Sunday 06.12.2020	Race 3 10:00* Race 4 12:30* Race 5 back to back with race 4 Presentation As soon as practical after the last race finishes.

* First warning signal not before the time indicated.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on-line on the club Website <https://lcsc.org.au/event/monomasters-and-junior-regatta/> at least one week before the event. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be made on the Club Notice Board and announced by the L flag and sound signal. They may also be sent by email to competitors.

7. COURSES

Triangular and windward/leeward courses will be used.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Australian Sailing yardsticks will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap. (see above 2.2)
- 8.2. 5 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 8.3. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 8.4. When 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 9.2. Best junior skipper under the age of 18.
- 9.3. Best woman on water
- 9.4. Best senior sailor over 65 (age must be included in registration)
- 9.5. Classes of 5 or more boats may be awarded prizes.
- 9.6. Other prizes may be awarded.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event.
