NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing 2020-24](#) (RRS), the [The Special Regulations of Australian Sailing](#), the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1.** Entries are invited from all classes of off the beach multihulls, off the beach monohulls, sailboards and trailer sailers (TS).

2.2. A-Class State Titles scheduled at the Lake at the same time have their own NOR

- 2.3. The fleet will be divided into 6 divisions using [Australian Sailing Yardsticks](#) (YS): (TS will be handicapped using the current Class Based Handicap (CBH), adjusted by the conversion formula to YS. It is imperative that full boat details should be entered in order to enable correct and equitable handicapping.)

Division 1 – A-Class Cats

Division 2 - multihulls YS below 79,

Division 3 - multihulls YS 79 and above,

Division 4 - monohulls YS below 112,

Division 5 - monohulls YS 112 and above.

Division 6 – Weta

The Race Committee may change or combine the divisions.

- 2.4. Eligible boats **must** enter by using [Easter Regatta Online Registration](#) .
[Registration & Payment](#) must be received before 17:00 on Thursday 14th April 2022.
- 2.5. **BEACH ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED – ONLINE ENTRY ONLY**

3. FEES

- 3.1. Competitor 18 years of age and older: \$75 (LCSC members: \$65).
- 3.2. Competitor under the age of 18 years: \$40 (LCSC members: \$30).

When a Lunch Break is scheduled, the appropriate flags will be flown off the committee boat.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on-line at the LCSC website. No printed copies will be issued by LCSC, Changes and FINAL copy shall be posted on the notice board at the base of club house steps.

6. COURSES

Triangular and windward/leeward courses may be used.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Australian Sailing yardsticks will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap.
- 7.2. 9 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.3. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 7.4. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score (1 drop).
- 7.5. When 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst two scores (2 drops)

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 8.2. Best sailor under the age of 18 in each division.
- 8.3. Classes of 5 or more boats may be awarded prizes.
- 8.4. Best Senior over 65 (Must nominate on registration)
- 8.5. Best Woman on Water.
- 8.6. Other prizes may be awarded.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event.
