NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the <u>Racing Rules of Sailing 2020-</u> <u>24-(</u>RRS),the <u>The Special Regulations of Australian Sailing</u>, the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all Non Foiling Moths
- 2.2. The fleet (depending numbers) may be split into more than one division. The Race Committee may change or combine the divisions.
- 2.3. Eligible boats <u>must</u> enter by using <u>Regatta Online Registration</u>. Registration & Payment must be received before 17:00 on Friday 11th February 2022.
- 2.4. BEACH ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ONLINE ENTRY ONLY (enter link here) (If you have issues entering contact <u>todd@metromoney.com.au</u> or call 0411220601 – please *do not* wait till arriving at the lake)

3. FEES

- 3.1. Competitor 18 years of age and older: \$65.
- 3.2. Competitor under the age of 18 years: \$40.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on-line at the LCSC website. No printed copies will be issued by LCSC, Changes and FINAL copy shall be posted on the notice board at the base of club house steps.

6. COURSES

Triangular and windward/leeward courses may be used.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Scratch and PBH, low point score system.
- 7.2. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap during the regatta.
- 7.3. 5 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.4. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 7.5. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score (1 drop).

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 8.2. Other prizes may be awarded.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
