NOTICE OF RACE

1.0 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the [Racing Rules of Sailing 2020-24](#) (RRS), [The Special Regulations of Australian Sailing](#), the class rules of the competing boats and by the Sailing Instructions.

RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a 360°-Turn Penalty.

2.0 ENTRIES

The Jack Holt regatta invites entries from all classes designed by Jack Holt. Examples include the Heron, Pacer, Mirror, International Cadet, National E (Lazy E), Solo, GP 14 and Enterprise.

The Heron Championships is open to all boats of the Heron Class with an A Class Certificate entered in the Jack Holt regatta. Skippers must be financial members of NHSAA Inc.

The Pacer championship is open to all boats of the Pacer Class entered in the Jack Holt Regatta.

The May Day Regatta invites all other Monohull classes with an Australian Sailing Yardstick of 118.5 or more.

Payment must be received before 11:00am on 29th April 2022.

3.0 FEES

Series entry fee to the regatta: \$75 per boat. (Note this is a flat fee now discounted from previous years) LCSC members \$65 per boat.

5.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on-line at the LCSC website. No printed copies will be issued by LCSC, but a copy may be posted on the notice board.

6.0 COURSES

Triangle and windward/leeward courses may be used as described in the Sailing Instructions

7.0 SCORING

Up to 7 races are scheduled, two races will constitute a series.

When four races or less have been completed, then a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.

When more than four races then a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score (1 drop)

Heron Championship

1st, 2nd, 3rd overall.

1st Junior skipper and crew both 17 years and under on 4th May 2022

1st Lady skipper

Pacer Championship

1st, 2nd, 3rd overall.

1st Junior skipper and crew both 17 years and under on 4th May 2022

May Day Regatta:

1st, 2nd, 3rd overall.

** Other prizes may be awarded at the race committee's discretion.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

11.0 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event.
