Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24 (RRS), the special regulations of Australian Sailing, the class rules of the competing boats and by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One Turn Penalty.
- 1.3. **Arbitration** as prescribed in Appendix T of the RRS will be available and scoring penalties may be applied as prescribed in RRS 44.3.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of off the beach monohulls, sailboards, trailer sailor boats and Weta trimarans & RL 24.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into 4 divisions using Australian Sailing Yardsticks (YS): (TS will be handicapped using the current CBH, adjusted by the conversion formula to YS. It is imperative that full boat details/modifications should be entered to enable correct and equitable handicapping.)

Division 1 - Monohulls YS greater than 127.5.

Division 2 - Monohulls YS 109 to 127.5,

Division 3 - Monohulls YS below 109,

Division 4 - Weta 1-up and 2-up & RL24

The Race Committee may change the divisions.

- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter online through the LCSC Club <u>website</u> and directly at https://www.revolutionise.com.au/lcsc/events/163102/. Registration will open on the 6th of November.
- 2.4. No cash/paper payment will be accepted.
- 2.5. Registration and payment must be completed by 5pm, Friday 2nd December 2022

3. ENTRY FEES

3.1. General \$75 (LCSC members: \$65)

(Junior skipper under 18 at date of event: \$35 discount)

3.2. Weta \$100 (LCSC Members \$90)

(Junior skipper under 18 at date of event: \$35 discount)

3.3. RL24 \$115 (RL24 Financial Members \$100)

LCSC discount: further \$10 respectively (\$105/\$90)

A maximum of 5 races will be run. Competitors should watch for signals indicating that a lunch break will take place on Sunday.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The sailing instructions will be available on-line on the club <u>website</u> at least one week before the event. Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be made on the Club Notice Board and announced by the L flag and sound signal. They may also be sent by email to competitors.

6. COURSES

Triangular and windward/leeward courses will be used.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Australian Sailing yardsticks will be used. The race committee may adjust any boat's handicap. (see above 2.2)
- 7.2. 7 races are scheduled of which one race must be completed to form the regatta.
- 7.3. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores.
- 7.4. When 5 races have been completed, a boat's final score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

8. PRIZES

- 8.1. Overall prizes in each division.
- 8.2. Best junior skipper under the age of 18.
- 8.3. Best woman on water
- 8.4. Best senior sailor over 65 (age must be included in registration)
- 8.5. Other prizes may be awarded.
- 8.6. Weta & RL24 prizes as supplied by their class associations.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Racing Rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a third-party insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event. Certificate of Currency to be presented at registration.
