1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)2021-2024, the special regulations of Australian Sailing and the Sailing Instructions for the event.
- 1.2. The rules of the competing classes apply. Boats failing to comply with their class rules will have their yardstick adjusted by the race committee.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of trailable boats, off the beach monohulls and multihulls and from sailboards.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into three divisions using Australian Sailing Yardsticks (YS): Trailer Sailors will be handicapped using the current Class Based Handicap (CBH) adjusted by the conversion formula to YS. It is imperative that full boat details should be entered in order to enable correct and equitable handicapping.

Division 1 - Monohulls, Trailer Sailers and Sailboards - YS below 150

Division 2 - Multihulls - YS less than 78.

Division 3 - Multihulls - YS 78 and greater.

Division 4 - Weta

The Race Committee reserves the right to change the divisions including adding divisions for classes.

All registrations must be done online. No cash or card payments will be accepted. Late entries accepted but must be lodged online before 10:30 on Saturday 26th August 2023 together with the required fee and a late entry fee of \$50.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee for the regatta is \$85.00 (LCSC members: \$75).
- 3.2. For competitors under the age of 18 at the date of the regatta the entry fee is \$50 (LCSC members: \$40). Boat to be skippered and crewed person(s) under the age of 18.
- 3.3. Additional late entry fee \$50.



4. SCHEDULE: UP TO 7 races will be conducted for the Regatta.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club website at https://lcsc.org.au/event/august-allboats-regatta-2/

Changes will be posted on notice board at the foot of the clubhouse stairs.

6. COURSES

Windward leeward & triangle courses will be used.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

For all classes RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

7.1 Arbitration as prescribed in Appendix T of the RRS will be available and scoring penalties may be applied as prescribed in RRS 41.3.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute the regatta.
- 8.2. a) When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores.
 - b) When 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.
- 8.3. Up to 7 races are scheduled.

9. PRIZES

The following prizes will be awarded based on yardstick positions: Overall positions in each division.

Ancient mariner aged over 65 years.

Best Woman on Water (Skipper or Crew)

Best Junior on water. (under 18 on 26th August 2023)

Other prizes may be awarded.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

12. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent.
