Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)2021-2024, the special regulations of Australian Sailing and the Sailing Instructions for the event.
- 1.2. The rules of the competing classes apply. Boats failing to comply with their class rules may have their yardstick adjusted by the race committee.

2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. Entries are invited from all classes of trailable boats, off the beach monohulls and multihulls and from sailboards.
- 2.2. The fleet will be divided into four divisions as follows:
 - Division 1 - Monohulls, Trailer Sailers and Sailboards – YS below 150
 - Division 2 - Multihulls – YS less than 78.
 - Division 3 - Multihulls – YS 78 and greater.
 - Division 4 - Wetas
- 2.3. Trailer Sailors will be handicapped using the current Class Based Handicap (CBH) adjusted by the conversion formula to YS. It is imperative that full boat details should be entered in order to enable correct and equitable handicapping.
- 2.4. The Race Committee reserves the right to change the divisions including adding divisions for classes.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter at <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/lcsc/events/248045> prior to 11.59pm on 28/8/2024.
- 2.6. Late entries will be accepted up to 10:00am on Saturday 31/8/2024.
- 2.7. All entries must be made online. No cash or card payments will be accepted.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Entry fee for the regatta is \$85.00 (LCSC members: \$75).
- 3.2. For competitors under the age of 18 at the date of the regatta the entry fee is \$50 (LCSC members: \$40). Boat to be skippered and crewed person(s) under the age of 18.
- 3.3. Late entries will be charged an additional \$50.
- 3.4. All fees are inclusive of GST.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Up to 7 races will be conducted for the regatta.
- 4.2. The following Schedule is planned:

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be posted on the Lake Cootharaba Sailing Club website at <https://lcsc.org.au/event/august-allboats-regatta-3/> and on the club notice board adjacent to the stairs leading up to the club entrance.
- 5.2. Any amendments will be posted on notice board.
- 5.3. No hardcopy versions of the sailing instructions will be available unless prior arrangements have been made.

6. COURSES

- 6.1. Windward leeward & triangle courses will be used as specified in the sailing instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 7.1. For all classes RRS rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2. When less than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores.
- 8.3. When 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.
- 8.4. Up to 7 races are scheduled.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. The following prizes will be awarded based on yardstick positions:
 - a. Overall positions in each division.
 - b. Ancient mariner aged over 65 years.
 - c. Best Woman on Water (Skipper or Crew)
 - d. Best Junior on water (under 18 on 1st August 2024)
 - e. Other prizes may be awarded.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. TELEVISION AND PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS

- 11.1. Competitors give permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

12. INSURANCE

- 12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent. By entering the event, each competitor declares that they have the required insurance cover. LCSC will not be liable if a competitor declares that they have insurance and it subsequently transpires that this was not true.
