On Sunday **19 January** 2024 we will share the course with Raceboards during their National Championships. The following changes to the Sailing Instructions apply:

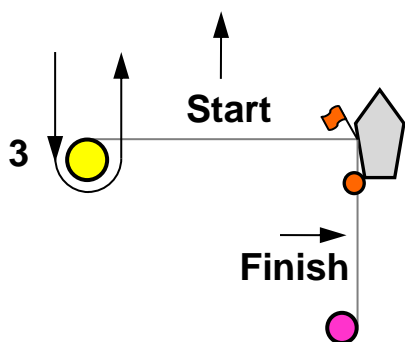
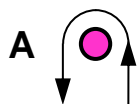
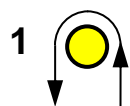
6. Attachment A is changed as illustrated on the next page.
  - 6.1. *The 3 min starting sequence is not changed for club racing boats (div. 1-4) but be aware the Raceboards (div. R) start with a 5 min sequence according to RRS 26.*
  - 6.3. Divisions may be combined at the start.
  - 7.4. Course 1 or 2 will be set.
  - 8.1. Marks 1, 2 and 3 will be yellow inflatable buoys.
  - 8.2. Marks A and B will be pink buoys.
  - 9.2. The start line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the start boat at the starboard end and the yellow mark 3 at the port end.
10. The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat at the port end and a pink mark at the starboard end.
- 12.1. Online registration must be submitted by 16:00.
- 12.2. Deleted. No on water check in with the start boat is required.

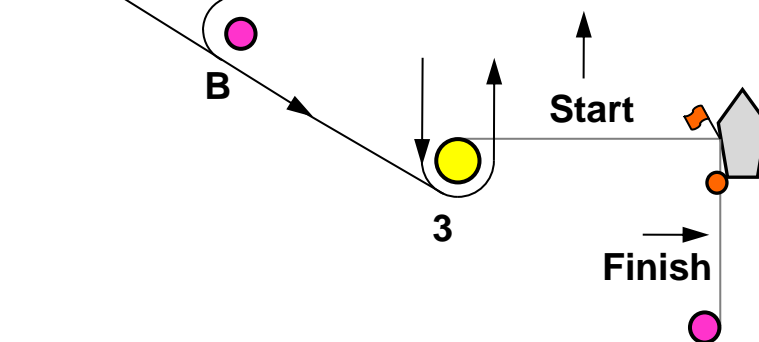
