



BOAT STORAGE - Terms & Conditions

1. All boats are stored at the owner's risk and the club accepts no liability for any loss or damage.
2. Storage will be available primarily for sailing vessels. At its discretion, the Executive Committee may permit storage for other boats or vehicles.
3. Boat storage is available on an annual basis to financial members of LCSC (this excludes Social Memberships). A new application will be required before the start of each season.
4. Storage shall be allocated at the discretion of the Boat Housing Officer.
5. Members with boats in storage (all locations) are expected to participate in the club's activities. Members who appear not to have participated in the club's activities, will be given the opportunity to provide an explanation for why they should retain boat storage.
6. Boat storage sites (if available) will **only** be allocated on receipt of a signed *Boat Storage Application* form. Members will then be invoiced for applicable storage fees and, for those under the Club and in the Top Shed, full season race fees.
7. Boat storage commencing after 1 January will be discounted by 50%.
8. Priority for storage under the Club (excluding sailboards) and in the Top Shed will be provided to members regularly involved in club racing.
9. Boats stored in the Top Shed and Yard must be on currently registered and fully functioning trailers. Trailer road wheels, jockey wheels and tow ball couplings are to be kept in good repair.
10. No major repairs or restorations are permitted on club storage premises.
11. Members must ensure that the boat storage space allocated to them is kept tidy with no items hindering access to other members' equipment.
12. Members must ensure boat covers, etc. are rigged to avoid the pooling of water which can provide a breeding ground for mosquitoes.
13. Members must comply with the relevant Australian Sailing Special Regulations:
 - i. AS Special Regulations Part 2 for dinghies and catamarans; and
 - ii. AS Special Regulations Part 1 Category 6 for trailer sailers; see <https://www.sailingresources.org.au/safety/specialregs/>
14. LCSC reserves the right to change the site allocated to a particular boat.
15. When written notice is given to any boat owner to remove a boat in club storage, the owner must comply within 30 days.
